

HOW TO CREATE A FLAVOR STATION

1. Select a site for the flavor station. It should be easily accessible to all students in a visible, high-traffic area. Good options are attached to the side of the salad bar, on a cart beside the salad bar, on a freestanding table or condiment station, or on the serving line itself (if there is only one serving line). If it is a cart, decorate the cart, if desired.



2. Choose and order spices and other items (vinegar cruets, lemon wedges, etc.). (Suggestion: Host a taste test to determine popular favorites.)



3. If the spices are not clearly labeled, create colorful, easy-to-read labels for each item. Add a taste description and food pairing for each item, either on the main label or on a chart posted on the cart.



4. Create a fun, colorful sign saying "Flavor Station," "Savor the Flavor!," "Flavor Town," etc.

5. Train staff to promote the flavor station and prompt students to try it out.
